1. Welcome, introductions and declarations of interest

- The Chair welcomed members and officials to the Quality Assurance Committee ("the committee") meeting.
- II. The Chair asked committee members whether they had any declarations of interest to make. All committee members recognised that should a potential or actual conflict arise by virtue of their other interests (outlined in the declaration of interests) then it must be raised at the outset of the relevant meeting which deals with the issue giving rise to the actual or potential conflict. The committee noted the update and was pleased to see progress. The committee requested sight of OfS/ QAA EQA reports prior to the end of 2021 through the Qualitas digital portal.
